Students learn how to get a cannabis job, how to become a medical marijuana patient, how to become a licensed cannabis grower, or caregiver in their state or country.

Occupational Objective: The graduate will have an understanding of the history of marijuana, marijuana laws in America & around the world, how to cultivate marijuana, how to set up a marijuana grow, how to cook with marijuana, marijuana extraction methods, bud tending skills, marijuana as a medicine, and how to breed marijuana.

The graduate should be able to acquire entry-level employment in the medical marijuana industry and be able to grow with, cook with, and prepare marijuana extractions for medicinal purposes in areas where local law permits. The candidate will have the opportunity to take and pass the online exam leading to a certificate of completion that states of their accomplishment from the cannabis industry's most respected online training program.

CLASS SCHEDULES

Students can log in and view class content and all the materials at any time day or night, 365 days a year. Class times are not relevant, rather an open format which allows each student to learn at their own pace, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

Prospective students may enroll anytime. Anyone may enroll in CTU's courses.

POSTPONEMENT OF START DATE

After signing up at CTU, the student can begin at any time. Each student gets a full 365 days of access. No monthly recurring payments are required. Students can log in and begin on their own schedule and advance as quickly or slowly as they prefer. Students can finish the entire program in as little as a week if they are in a hurry, although most students finish the program within thirty days.

PLACEMENT ASSISTANCE

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS

There is no attendance requirement.

All digital e-books included in any of the courses are downloadable and can remain accessible for the student indefinitely, except for those written by Ed Rosenthal which the student can view for the entire year but cannot download to their device.

PROGRESS POLICY

In order to pass the CTU Master of Marijuana Certification program a score of a minimum of 80% must be achieved.

There are no progress reports sent to students and there is no probationary period.

GRADING SYSTEM

After passing, students will immediately be able to download and print their CTU Master of Marijuana Certificate from their computer.

If after passing the exam, any student is unable to download the certificate for any reason, CTU can email the student a copy of their earned CTU certificate upon request.
